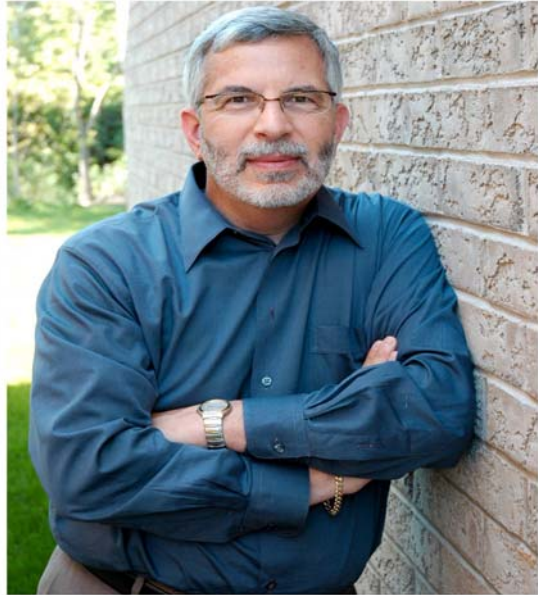


# Hard of Hearing: Can you relate to that?
